Caring for your CUT TREE

For best quality & freshness they are cut late so that, with the right care, they will last the festive season.

Top Tips

- ✓ If you are not going to putting your tree up straight away, store outside in a cool, dry, wind-sheltered spot in a bucket of water so that the tree can drink
- ✓ Just before bringing your tree inside, saw about 3cm (1 inch) off the bottom of the trunk to open up the pores in the bark to allow water to be taken up
- ✓ Stand the tree in plain water (not soil or sand) as soon as possible after sawing. Place your tree in a water-holding stand, away from direct heat such as radiators & keep it watered regularly



Keep your water level topped up

DID YOU KNOW?

Christmas trees may drink up to 2-3 pints of water per day. So remember to keep the water level topped up.
