# Our pot-grown Christmas trees are the ecological festive option.

Grown in pots from the start, they can be brought inside for the festive season and then planted outdoors in the New Year.

## Sustainability

Our British pot-grown Christmas trees have taken many years to get to their current size, having started as seedlings. They are delivered in a special climate bag to help retain moisture and the micro-climate around their roots, keeping them fresh for festive period.

By following these simple steps, your tree will thrive and grow on after Christmas:



## When you get home

- ✓ Remove any netting and water well.
- ✓ Once you're ready to bring indoors, place into a decorative pot that can hold water and place a large plant saucer underneath.
- ✓ Keep the soil moist at all times, especially when the central heating is on.
- ✓ After the festive period, return the tree outdoors.

## Get ready for planting

- ✓ Dig a hole of the same depth and twice as wide as the pot.
- ✓ Loosen the soil in the bottom of the hole.
- ✓ Gently remove the climate bag and grow pot, taking care not to disturb the root ball too much.
- ✓ Place the tree in the hole and back fill with a 50:50 mix of topsoil and general-purpose compost.
- ✓ Gently firm in place and water well.
- ✓ Water generously in the first-year of establishment.
